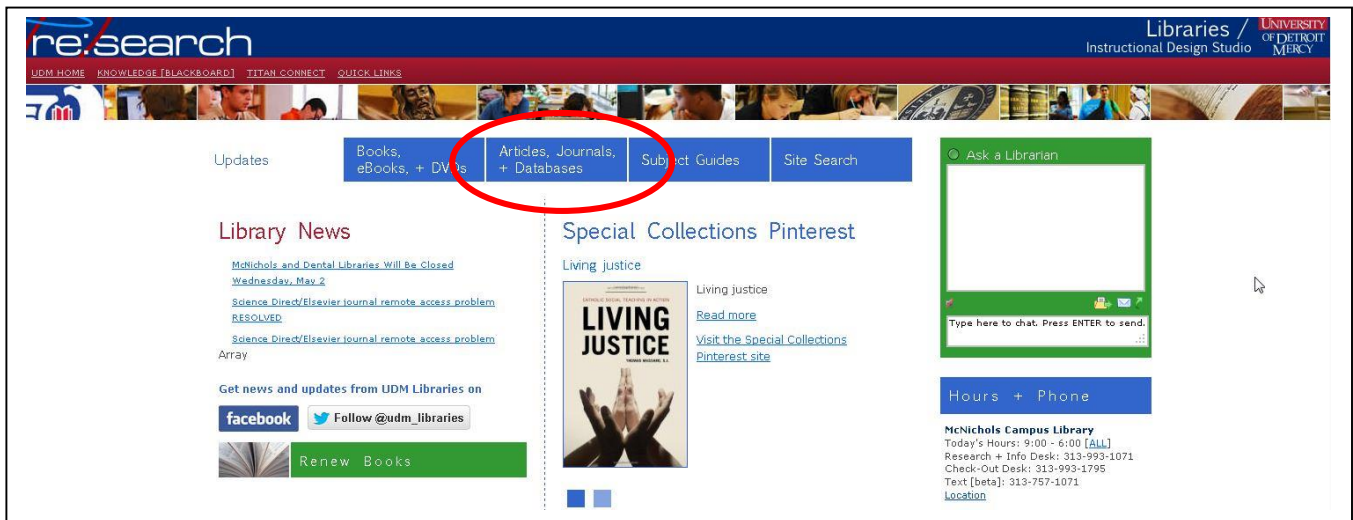


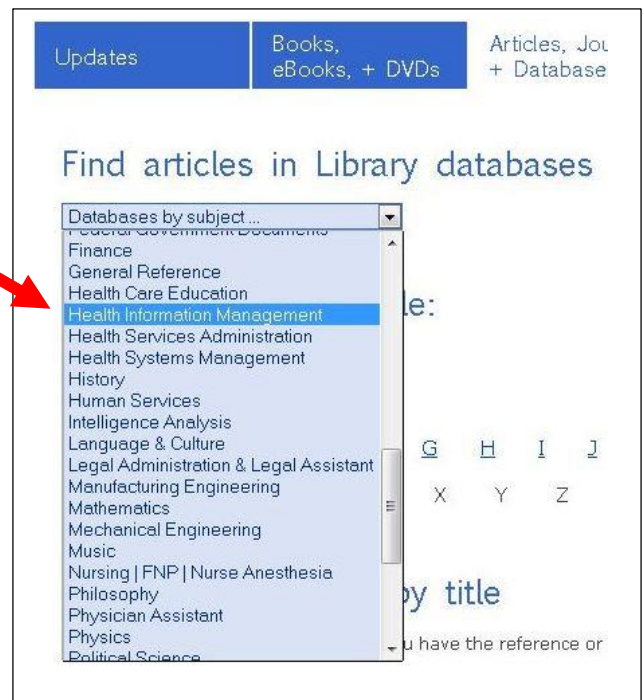
# Accessing Health Sciences Databases

1. Go to the **UDM Library Website – research.udmercy.edu**
2. Select the **Articles Journals, + Databases** tab at the top of the page.

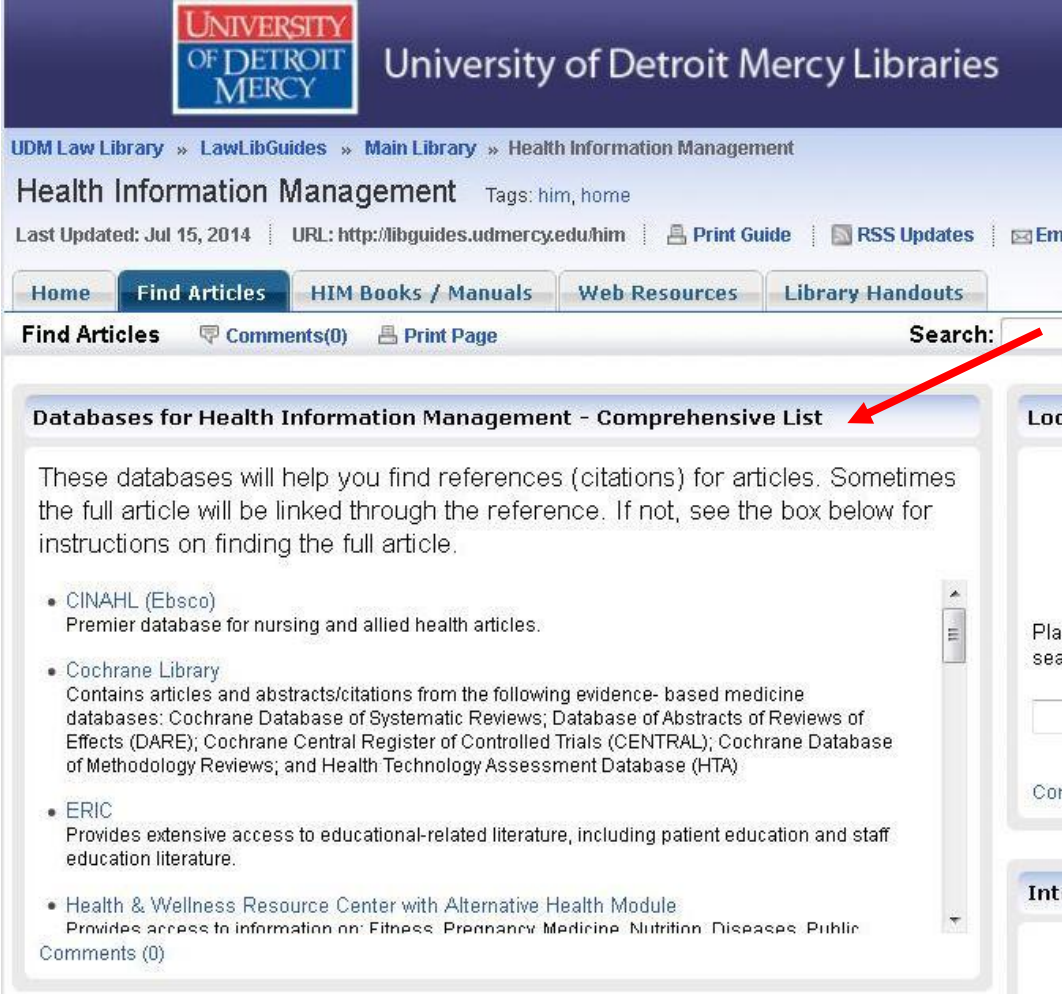
